It's designated as NPOTA, or National Parks on the Air, and is in commemoration of the 100 year anniversary of the establishment of the National Parks Service. NPO-TA is an ARRL organized event, but relatively informal. A contest of sorts, but usually without the chaos of a rare DX contest, and with 438 potential activations sites and at various dates throughout the entire 2016 year, It's great fun and an opportunity to increase the number of entries in your station log.

There are two groups of station: Activators and

Chasers. If you want to grab a few NPOTA contacts from your home station or even mobile, or portable, and are not a registered Activator, then you are a Chaser. If you are a registered Activator, then there are some simple rules that apply. All ACTIVATOR operations must be portable, and within the boundaries of the National Park Unit (NPU) that they are operating as. The one exception is, ops acting as a NPU who live and maintain their home station on land owned by the NPU boundaries qualify. CHASERS may operate from a wide variety of stations and locations, so long as they are outside of the NP unit that they are logging..

Various NP units will have Activator stations on the air at various times throughout the entire year, so if you're relatively new to HF or the world of contesting, this is a great opportunity to gain some experience in these types of operations, and at your own convenience, as time allows. There is an online list showing current Activation schedules as well as future planned vator by registering with the ARRL, reviewing a few simple rules, and heading out to a NP Unit

Raffle Report



This month's \$5 raffle prize is another Icom ID-31A UHF Digital Transceiver.

The ID-31A has a look and feel along with a new user interface packed into slim, compact chassis protected with IPX7 submersible construction.

The built-in GPS receiver shows your current position and altitude for GPS position reporting function and the GPS log function tracks your move-

ment. The ID-31A has a micro SD card slot which can be used for storing GPS log, voice memory and memory contents.

The large full dot-matrix display, directional keypad and quick menu button also ease the usability. Accessing a D-STAR (Digital Smart Technology for Amateur Radio) repeater has been made even easier.

The K7RA Solar Update 3/18/16

Solar indicators were lower this week, while geomagnetic indicators were higher.

Compared to the previous seven days. average daily sunspot numbers in our reporting week (March 10-16) were down 12.7 points to 51.7, and average daily solar flux was down 3.2 points to 93.6. Average planetary A index was up 2.8 points to 15.7, and average midlatitude A index increased from 8.6 to

The latest forecast has a predicted solar flux of 95 on March 18-19, 90 on March 20, 85 on March 21-24, 90 on March 26-28, 100 on March 29-31, 95 on April 10-9, 93 on April 11-15, 95 on April 16-17, and 90 on April 18-19. Flux values then rise to 100 on April 25-27.

Predicted planetary A index is 16, 8, 6 and 5 on March 18-21, then 6, 8 and 10 on March 22-24, 5 on March 25-31, then 8, 30, 25 and 8 on April 1-4, and 5 on April 5-6. Planetary A index rises to 25 on April 11 and 30 on April 29.



Membership News from last Board meeting

Adopted February 1, 2016, by the SOARA Board of Directors at the regular monthly Board meeting. I will update the SOARA membership application soon.

- 1. The initiation fee may be waived for members joining during the actual field day activity only.
- 2. New members to pay full membership fee at the current rate. Second year renewal will be prorated.
- 3. October 1 is the member dues renewal date.
- 4. Past members who left in good standing, that want to rejoin, we will waive the initiation fee indefinitely for those that previously have paid the fee. If a past member did not pay the initiation fee, (Example: joining at field day), the limit would be 2 years or less from their last payment record. After the two year membership lapse passes, members rejoining are required to pay the current initiation fee amount, in addition to their annual dues amount.
