Repeater Director Report

Santiago 440 Repeater Update

We owe Richard (K6RBS) a debt of gratitude in finding two of the repeaters involved in the mixing that has been causing unwanted interference by producing a signal with qualifying PL on the input of our Santiago 447.180 machine.

One of the system owners recently updated their PL erroneously to 131.8 which provided the necessary PL tone to key up our repeater when the other three were active.

The repeater keeper for the repeater that has our PL on its output will be updating that as soon as he can. Until then, he has suggested that they can unlink it from their system to reduce the activity. We've asked them to do that.

Even with the PL changed, we will likely hear the results of the mixing on the input along with other stations, mostly weaker stations (e.g. HTs). A normal user who is transmitting on the input frequency with a qualifying PL should easily overpower the weaker signal produced by the mixing.

SOARA September 30, 2018 Year End Financial Report

The following is SOARA's Statement of Revenue and Expenses for Fiscal Year 2017-18. Maintaining our network of repeaters is SOARA's largest expense, and including insurance these costs comprised 73% of membership dues & initiation fees last year. Please note that we used very little of the budget allocated for Repairs and Maintenance this past year, and the Board has voted to carryover a portion of the remaining budget into 2018-19 in anticipation of some needed upgrades resulting in higher expenses Revenue:
